A	Turtle crossings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Chemin Alderbrooke and rue Western Sud - \$2,500 - Installation of signage and information sheets - Every year, turtles cross the road at the southern end of Alderbrooke Road, heading inland from where the Sutton and Alderbrooke rivers meet. Unfortunately, every year, some of them are killed by cars travelling too fast to see them and avoid them. - The aim of this project is to establish a turtle crossing in the first 250 metres of the southern part of Alderbrooke Road (and on Western South) by installing a sign warning of turtles crossing and a reduced speed notice. 	H	Under the canopy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bike path - \$50,000 - The Sentier salade de fruits project involves creating an edible landscape in five sections, one next to the other, in the section of the cycle path that runs alongside the Villas des Monts and the community garden. The aim is to create five green environments in which to slow down and linger. These facilities will be developed alongside the cycle path. They will be accessible to pushchairs and wheelchairs. Each green space will be complemented by street furniture, plant interpretation panels and haikus (short poems in three lines), celebrating the beauty of the area. The themes will be: eating, relaxation, sharing, fun and contemplation.

<p>B</p>	<p>Beautifying the entry to the Town</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tarte Park - \$25,000 - When you arrive in the village, spring, summer and autumn, you come across a large triangle of green grass dotted with tables and benches... but it would be much more attractive to add some colourful greenery. A nice mix of perennial flowers and hardy, easy-care shrubs would brighten up the arrival and the flowerbeds of these noble places: a beautiful arrival. - A flagstone terrace could be laid out to accommodate the tables, and a triangle following the shape of the ground could house a beautiful mix of herbs and flowers, a bit like an English garden. - The promotional sign could be reviewed and integrated into the ambience to be created. 	<p>I</p>	<p>Give a soul to Gagné Park</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gagné park - \$50,000 - Bring back vitality to the park much appreciated by families for its tranquility and its location, easily accessible on foot, from Principale North Road and homes nearby. - Install a gazebo, picnic tables, BBQ area, to allow for gatherings of neighbors and other Sutton residents or visiting cyclists. - Layout an area to access the stream by removing the fence and adding a pathway respecting the stream. - Return of a few swings and a climbing structure (spiderlike).

C	Outdoor ping-pong table	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Goyette-Hill Park OR Filtex - \$15,000 - Install an outdoor ping-pong table with a permanent net to allow citizens to easily start a game with their own racket and ball. Young and old can partake in the game, almost year-round. Heated tables are even available. 	K	Two-generation swings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Villa des Monts AND Foyer Sutton - \$10,000 - These swings can be used by a child and a parent simultaneously.
D	Dog run	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Puits Street - \$50,000 - Laying out a secure area dedicated to dog exercise. 	L	Gazebo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Filtex - \$40,000 - Install a covered gazebo on the grass, octagonal or round shape, which could be used for artistic and community activities. Concerts, presentations, different styles of music, public events, theatre, choirs, dance classes could be held in it. Could also be available for rental by citizens, for weddings, family reunions. It could be used by the school, daycare, day camps or activities organized for children and adults. -

E	A gathering place	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Filtex - \$50,000 - A levelled and packed area of about 100m diameter with a fire pit as its focal point, 6–8 picnic tables under shade screening, power points at the perimeter for pop-up stalls and food vendors. 	M	Veterans Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Veterans Park - \$25,000 - Improve the Veterans Park by creating a new landscape of relaxation areas combining perennial flowers, shrubs and existing trees. Under the concept of a nourishing forest, among other things, people could circulate on paths with the installation of Japanese steps. - The site should be a restful, attractive space for biodiversity and people alike. - Artists' sculptures (linked to the gentleness of nature) or wooden privacy structures could also be integrated into the park.
F	Peaceful oasis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Foyer Sutton - \$25,000 - Installation of a decorative fountain and flowerbeds filled with flowers, installation of benches in shady areas. 	N	Information while strolling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bicycle Path, towards Principale Street - \$2,500 - Install a fixed information board similar to the one near the Gazebo to inform the population about activities and events.
